



ABOUT SPARC-India

SPARC-India, established in 1996 stresses on community based rehabilitation (CBR) along with development initiatives for children with disabilities (CwDs) and persons with disabilities (PwDs) in urban as well as rural regions. SPARC-India is a registered society under the Registrar Chit Funds and Society registration Act 1860 under registration no. 597 (1996).

The thrust of our programs is on education, health, skill development, livelihood generation medical rehabilitation, formation of self-help groups (SHGs) of PwDs/their families and to establish linkages with government schemes through advocacy of rights and entitlements. SPARC-India established Jyoti Kiran School (JKS) for the children suffering from cerebral palsy in 2003. SPARC-India formed Advocacy groups in 2007 and established Uttar Pradesh Viklang Manch (UPVM) in 2009. A local trust helped in initiating a vocational training and placement cell for youths with disabilities (YwDs) in 2010. Vocational Unit trains women with disabilities (WwDs) and marginalized women. So far, SPARC-India has an outreach in 30 districts of Uttar Pradesh (UP) through its PACS Program which was supported by DFID, UK.

1 JYOTI KIRAN SCHOOL (JKS)

JKS, running since 2003, caters to the needs of CwDs like education, therapeutic interventions, counseling etc and mainstream them in regular schools.

2 INCLUSIVE EDUCATION PROGRAM

SPARC-India through its Inclusive Education Program in Lucknow is working in 10 government primary school of the district to ensure inclusive school practices in them.

3 SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND PLACEMENT PROGRAM

Skill development and placement program ensures that YwDs have better skills and livelihood options and job security.

4 VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTER

SPARC-India has been running a vocational training centre since 2010 which essentially addresses the professional and employment potentials of WwDs and supports their self employment initiatives.

5 SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM

SPARC-India representatives visit the homes of CwDs through its sponsorship program to strengthen their activities of daily living and mainstream them in regular schools













SPARC INDIA'S ACHIEVEMENTS APRIL 2022 - MARCH 2023



Towards creating inclusive schools, SPARC-India in collaboration with SBI Foundation organized a one-day Orientation Program of Resource Teachers (Govt. special educators) on Inclusive Education on 26th July 2022 at DIET Hall, Nishat Ganj, Lucknow with a perspective of orienting the Resource Teachers on the concept of Inclusive Education.



The new Vocational Unit batch of 16 women with disabilities and 17 non-challenged women from the marginalized sections of the society started from $23^{\rm rd}$ January 2023 and kit distribution of the program was held on $26^{\rm th}$ January 2023 at SPARC-India, Lucknow. The training course included stitching, tailoring and embroidery.



SPARC-India's Jyoti Kiran School celebrated its Annual Day on 25th March 2023 at CMS Auditorium, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow which was supported by Fiserv. and United Way. Ms Leena Seth (Director, Shalimar Corp. Ltd.) was the Chief Guest at the event. Students of Jyoti Kiran School and children from the community along with the trainees of Skill Development and Placement Program participated in the event with great enthusiasm and zeal.



SPARC-India in collaboration with KTL Automobile Pvt. Ltd organized a Sewing Machine Distribution Ceremony on 31st March 2023 at SPARC-India office in Madiaon Lucknow. SOME OTHER ACTIVITIES

APRIL 2022 - MARCH 2023

JYOTI KIRAN SCHOOL

SPARC-India in collaboration with **Fiserv**. and United Way, reopened Jyoti Kiran School (JKS) in the month of December 2022.

• The regular sessions of the students included a mix of education, physiotherapy and speech therapy sessions. Some of the activities included eye-hand coordination, attention and GMD activity; memory retention, attention enhancement, gripping, color concept and FMD activity; envelop making activity, tearing and pasting activity, paper cutting activity, flowerpot activity, music activity, clay activity etc.





















Parent Support Group meetings were organized on 23rd February 2023 and 29th March 2023 in which 18 and 15 parents were present respectively. Counseling of the parents was done in both the meetings. Since the progress of student is not only dependent on teachers but also their parents hence the JKS staff discussed strategies that can be followed at home to have a positive impact on the overall development of the children and the parents were also motivated to send their wards to school regularly.



SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND PLACEMENT PROGRAM

• The Batch - 17 of the residential Skill Development and Placement Program was held between 1st December 2022 and 31st March 2023. The program provided training on BPO, English, Basic Computer and Soft Skills. 25 youths with disabilities completed the program out of which 16 youths with disabilities were placed in different entry level positions in Corporate.



- \bullet Orientation Ceremony and Kit Distribution of Batch-17 trainees was organized on 19^{th} January 2023 at the SDP Center.
- Placement drives were held at STARTEK (Aegis) Pvt Ltd and Techno Task Business Solution Pvt Ltd Lucknow for the trainees of the SDP for the post of Customer Care Executive.
- In addition to the training sessions, solo and group activities including chart making activity, identification of input & output devices, computer and its peripheral devices, presentation of PowerPoint PPTs, alumni meet etc were also conducted.

INCLUSIVE EDUCATION PROGRAM

SPARC-India in collaboration with SBI Foundation initiated the Inclusive Education program in 10 Direct Govt. Primary Schools and 10 Indirect Schools in Lucknow from April 2022 for children with disabilities (CwDs). The following activities were conducted under the Inclusive Education Program:



"SCHOOL CHALEIN HUM" CAMPAIGN

"School Chale Hum" campaign was initiated in 10 government primary schools to ensure that each child including CwDs can be linked to formal education in regular schools and creating awareness for each child's right to education, importance of education and inclusive education.



"SIGNATURE" CAMPAIGN

"Signature" Campaign was initiated in which all the students signed on banner as their support for the right to education of CwDs.

INCLUSIVE CHILDREN'S PARLIAMENT ORIENTATIONS & ELECTIONS

Inclusive Children's Parliament (ICP) orientations were conducted in 15 schools to make the students aware of their rights along with the meaning, process of formation and benefits of ICP. ICP

formation and benefits of ICP. ICP elections were held in 2 schools to give practical experiences to students on democracy, its responsibility, accountability and on the supremacy of the law.

4 Nukkad Natak were performed by Natakbaaz team in different areas of Lucknow to create awareness on disability in the community. They depicted the plight of children / persons with disabilities & how if given chance they can do wonders for themselves, their family & society.

JYOTI KIRAN SCHOOL (JKS)

TAUHID



Tauhid is a 15-year-old boy having 50% mental retardation. His father works as a salesman, while his mother is a housewife. When Tauhid started coming to school, his behaviour was shy and hesitant in expressing his point of view but he did have little interest in creative work. After regular interventions and guidance, he was able to write number names 1 to 25 and 3 letter words in English. He used to complete his classwork with some help. But now he has started doing all his work on his own like homework, therapy etc. and shows interest in participating in activities. Tauhid's parents say that he is learning a lot through the school and slowly is also becoming self-dependent.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND PLACEMENT PROGRAM

PREETI



Preeti is a 20-year-old girl having 50% locomotor disability & belongs to Sitapur. She has completed Intermediate. Her father is a farmer and her mother is a house wife. She came to know about the Training Program through the SDP Team and appeared for the screening process in which she was selected. She performed well in class and participated in all the activities. She was one of those trainees who always smiled and performed all the responsibilities well. After successfully completing the training course, she received job offer from Life Path Care Marketing Pvt. Ltd., Lucknow as Care Sales Executive.

"I am thankful to SPARC-India and all the trainers who supported me and guided me in the training. I am happy with my current job." says Preeti.

GOVID RAWAT



Govind Rawat is a 27 year old boy who has 80% locomotor disability & belongs to Unnao. He has completed Intermediate. His father is no more and his mother is a house wife. Before joining the training, he gave private tuitions to children. He came to know about the training program through the SDP team. He needed to work on English and confidence skills. Trainers conducted special exercises to build his confidence so that he could speak in front of people. He successfully completed the training and was selected in Techno Task Business Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Lucknow as a Customer Care Executive.

"I am happy with the changes in my life after joining SDP training. I was placed in TTBS which is like a dream come true for me. I never thought I could be able to live in Lucknow independently. I am thankful to SPARC-India for supporting me throughout my training and interview process. Without them this would have been impossible." says Govind Rawat.

INCLUSIVE EDUCATION PROGRAM

RAJAN



Rajan is a 12-year-old boy with 50% Cerebral Palsy who lives in Mohibullapur, Lucknow. His father is a driver and his mother works as a maid in the houses of other people. The IE team explained to the parents about the benefits and overall development of the child by going to the school and hence his parents enrolled him in Upper Primary School Chhavni Madiaon. Seeing Rajan's condition, his family members agreed to bring him to school once a week instead of everyday. After seven months of efforts, he has become obedient and disciplined and now he knows and recognizes some numbers and letters of English and Hindi alphabet as well. On seeing the changes in Rajan's behaviours and attitude, his family members are very happy.

KARAN



Karan is a 14-year-old boy having 100% Cerebral Palsy who lives in Aliganj, Lucknow. His father is a labour and his mother works as a maid in other's houses. His parents did not enrol him in any school as they were worried about his well-being. During the intervention, the IE team assessed Karan after which his parents decided to enrol him at Primary School Ahibaranpur. His parents took the responsibility to drop him to school and take him back once or twice in a week. In the beginning Karan used to hesitate and was afraid to talk to people but now, he greets all the people he meets. He performs all the activity given to him with great attention. Karan's family members are very happy on seeing positive changes in him.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM

JULIE KASHYAP



Julie Kashyap is a 39-year-old woman with 90% PPRP of both lower limbs who lives in Gudiyan Purwa area of Jankipuram Lucknow. Her father doesn't work and her mother is a house wife. She has studied up to 8th standard. Julie came to know about tailoring program through Vocational Unit mobilizer. She joined the tailoring program and later on also joined the computer & beautician course under the program. She completed all the programs with great dedication and also used to help other trainees of the program whenever they needed any help. She is now self-employed and has opened up her own boutique. She is currently teaching 5 other females the skill of sewing and passing on what she has learnt.

स्पार्क-इंडिया वार्षिक प्रतिवेदन

स्पार्क इंडिया, जो कि 1996 में स्थापित हुआ था, शहरी और ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों में दिव्यांग बच्चों और दिव्यांग व्यक्तियों के लिए विकास की पहल के साथ समुदाय आधारित पुनर्वास पर जोर देता है। हमारे कार्यक्रमों का जोर शिक्षा, स्वास्थ्य, कौशल विकास, आजीविका उत्पादन, चिकित्सा पुनर्वास, दिव्यांगजनों एवं उनके परिवारों के स्वयं सहायता समूहों का गठन और अधिकारों की वकालत के माध्यम से सरकारी योजनाओं के साथ जोड़ने पर है। स्पार्क इंडिया ने 2003 में सेरेब्रल पाल्सी (सी. पी.) से पीड़ित बच्चों के लिए ज्योति किरण स्कूल की स्थापना की थी। स्पार्क इंडिया ने 2007 में वकालत समूहों का गठन किया और 2009 में उत्तर प्रदेश विकलांग मंच की स्थापना की। एक स्थानीय ट्रस्ट ने 2010 में दिव्यांग व्यक्तियों के लिए एक व्यावसायिक प्रशिक्षण और प्लेसमेंट सेल शुरू करने में मदद की। व्यावसायिक इकाई विकलांग महिलाओं और हाशिए की महिलाओं को प्रशिक्षित करती है। अब तक, स्पार्क इंडिया की पैक्स कार्यक्रम के माध्यम से उत्तर प्रदेश के 30 जिलों में पहुँच है जिसे डीएफआईडी, यू.के. द्वारा समर्थित किया गया था।


